



ATTACHMENT 4 MONITORING ASSIGNMENTS

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

Authorized originators may request a Legacy EAS activation through an LP station when the CAP platform is unavailable due to an Internet outage or failure. The request will be made through the station’s EAS “Hotline” or in person. Originators have been informed that LP stations may not be staffed or available 24/7. When the LP station receives such a request they should get the name, agency and callback number of the requesting Originator and prepare to record the EAS message and program the station’s EAS equipment. The station board operator should tell the authorized originator what procedures to follow to record the message. After recording the message and determining that the recording is less than 2 minutes and of good audio quality, and receiving contact information, the LP station staff can then issue the EAS activation.
